Sandgate Cemetery was opened in 1881 and has serviced the burial needs of Newcastle to this day. The total area of the cemetery is about 31 ha. There is a general lawn cemetery, above ground crypts, a 'garden of innocents' for infant burials and memorials, and special places for interment of ashes. The different sections of Sandgate Cemetery depict many aspects of funeral customs practised in past times. Sandgate Cemetery is the last resting place of over 85,000 citizens. The virtualisation of the cemetery through our website now brings the cemetery to the world.
