Bew Chip's Register is a rare, early primary source of evidence of remittances to China by Chinese goldminers on the Western Goldfields of New South Wales. Over a period of twenty-five years between 1865 and 1890, Bew Chip gave his countrymen on the goldfields gold dust and gold sovereigns to carry back to China. The Register is a record of the names, dates, and other important information of those who carried the remittances on his behalf.

Hear Dr. Kwok recount the fascinating tale of how this aspect of Chinese/Australian history has been revealed through translation & meticulous research.
